HOW TO EXPORT YOUR TRACKS BEFORE MIXING:

- Make a **copy** of your **project** and work on it.
- Make a **simple mix** of your song and send us. In this way we can understand your stylistic choices and work according to them.
- **Disable all plugins** on insert in audio tracks. If in your project there are **virtual instruments** or **rewire tracks** turn them into **audio tracks** and export also that.
- Delete unused tracks, remove unused files and save your project in a new folder.
- If you have important **stereo tracks** (for example an orchestral or an electronic drum session) create stereo mixdowns of them.
- **Export automation** lanes.
- Put the **left locator at beat 1** and **right locator at the end** of the song. **During exporting** keep the **fader** of the track **at 0 db**. Make sure that there are **no peaks**, put **the pan in the middle**.
- **Rename the tracks** clearly and indicate the **Bpm** of the project.
- **Do not normalize** in any way the tracks, **keep the maximum peaks between - 6 and - 3 dBFS**.
